





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Main Activities

- 2- Conduct HIV/AIDS and STI testing (Daytime and nighttime) (Finger Prick, HIV-ST)
- 3- Refer reactive cases to confirm test and treat ART services
- 4- Conduct positive KP's partner tracing
- 5- Conduct regular follow up visit to positive KPs
- 6- Promote condom and lubricant use among KP
- 7- Promote PrEP service among KP
- 8- Post Facebooks and live show
- 9- Perform risk screening among KP to define their risk status
- 10- Update GIS Mapping
- 11- Conduct field monitoring, evaluation and reporting
- 12- Conduct special events and attend in relevant stakholder meeting


Achievement for Annual (Jan-Dec) 2021

30,618 FEWS AEM-HIV/KPs sites estimation (PNP, KDL, PVG, SHV) data:UNAIDS








Trend of HIV Testing in period COVID-19 pandemic, 2021




FEWs in HIV-AIDS Cascade, 2021












FEWs data tracking on risk screening from Jul-Dec,2021

Key Program Leaning By Doing in 2021

Challenges

A. COVID-19 pandemic when lockdown can't physical reach and test in Q2

B. COVID-19 pandemic use virtual outreach can't distribute condoms due to under result of GF frameworks

C. 26% Outreach Workers turnover due to lost of lay counselors skill

D.1814 FEWs of mobile van night time service integrated to PNP-coverage more caseload from 250 to 320 per outreach

E. Increasing HIV/AIDS program (HIV-ST, PrEP) but no add more resource

F. Technology on DHIS2-GIS Claude Mapping doesn't adapt OWs who origional FEWs

Keys program learning by doing year of 2021

By challenging of COVID-19 pandemic in 20 Feb 2021 event (lockdown) CWPD learnt:

-CWPD initiated to develop QR code and scanning methods then instruct to OWs doing period of physical outreach make sure that FEWs can follow SMARTgirl page and OW Facebook accounts.

-CWPD's GIS-Mapping system update individual FEWs and EEs open or close by COVID-19 impact, OWs can provide core package service as greatest need of FEWs including condoms, foods, accommodations budget donned by KHANA, FHI360, Cambodian red cross and local authorities. Keys program learning by doing year of 2021

-KHANA CWPD and MHC developed PPE' guide note and distribute PPE's martial for physical outreach, and CWPD noted FEWs who receive COVID vaccination.

-CWPD and EMDR support FEWs to access mental health screening and treatment

-NCHADS-FHI360-KHANA built capacity of program staff on PrEP, HIV-ST, DHIS2, GIS and B-CoPCT service packages, both physical and virtual training.

-Attending program HIV-AIDS both national and under national health program and actively with special events and World AIDS Day.
